1. What do you see as the technical needs of this play (set, lights, costumes, props, ect.) based on your reading of the script?
2. If you were going to be cast in this play which part would you want to play if you could choose any character? Why does this character appeal to you? You may ignore age, sex, race or any other designator in your choice.
3. What real life person or fictional character does this character bring to mind? What are the similarities or differences that you see?
4. What are the similarities and/or differences that exist between you and the character that you chose?
5. Choose any other character in the play and tell how this character 's actions, personality, words, ect. affect your character.
6. What is your opinion of this play as a work of literature? deal with issues such as plot, conflict, character development, theme, ect.
